# Censo 2010

- ❖ The 2010 census considers “people with difficulty or permanent limitations” are those who inform to have “ a limitation in daily activities and restrictions in the participation, that arises in a deficiency (for example in seeing, hearing, , grasping objects, understanding, learning, etc.) and that affect a person in a permanent way to carry on in his/her daily life within his/her physical and social environment, (for example in education, leisure activities, at work, etc.)”.

**This definition allows us to capture those people who hold a disability certificate as well as those who do not hold one, but inform in having some/difficulty/ies or permanent/s limitation/s in seeing, hearing, moving, understanding or learning.**

Theoretical-conceptual framework: Health World Organization ( WHO) – International Classification of Functioning of Disability and Health, (ICF 2001).

Conceptual choices on limitations and permanent difficulties: in order to measure people with disability we need a more specific set of questions as well as the participation of specialized interviewers due to the complexity of disability as a topic.

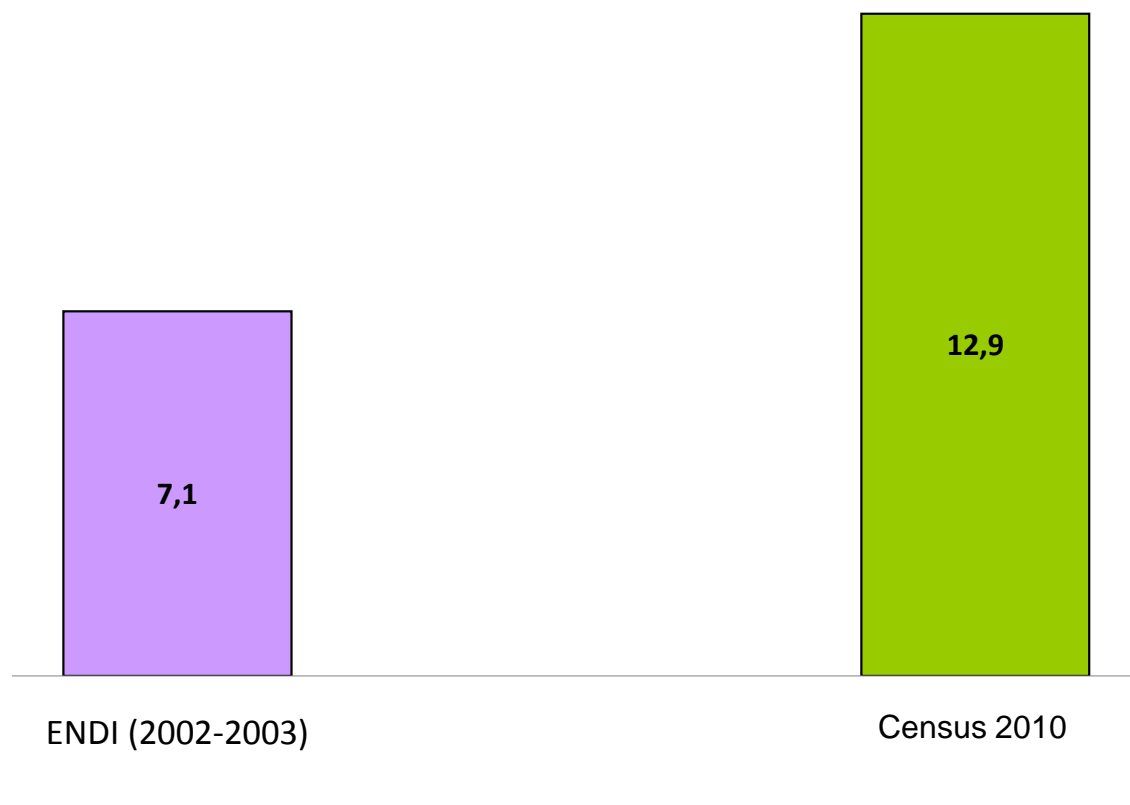

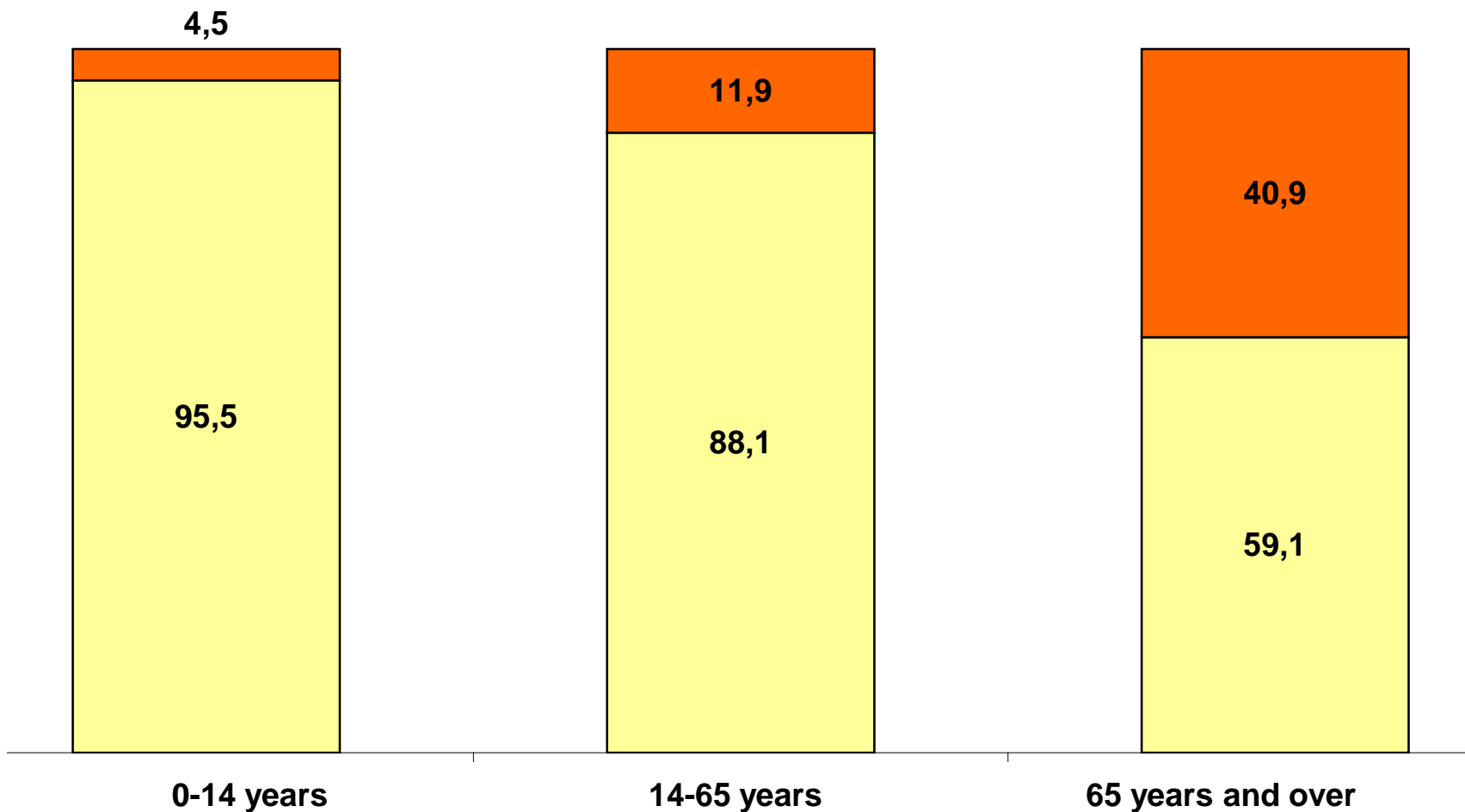

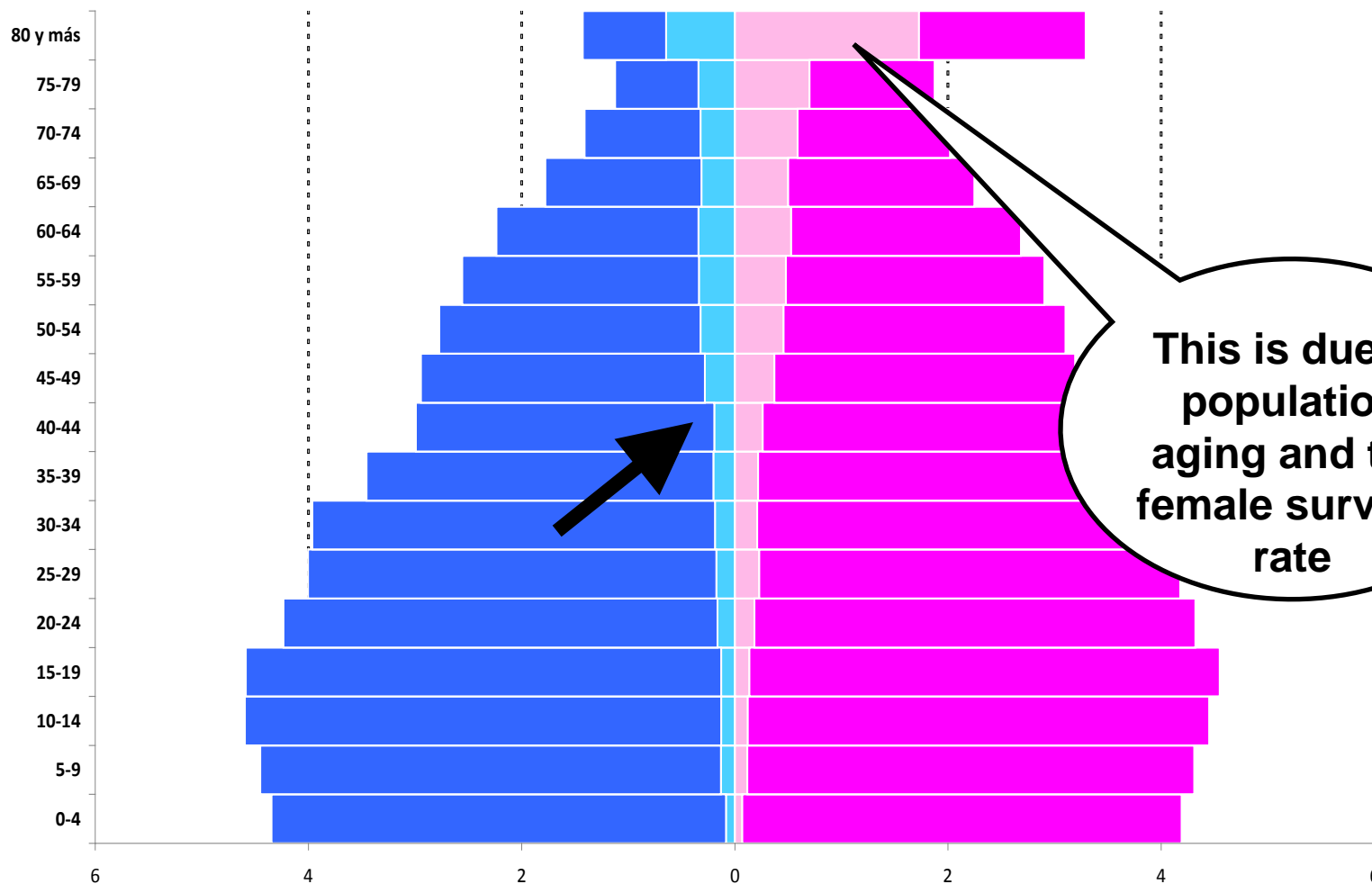
## Census 2010 – Prevalence in broad age groups – Country total

# Census 2010 – Population Pyramid – Country total

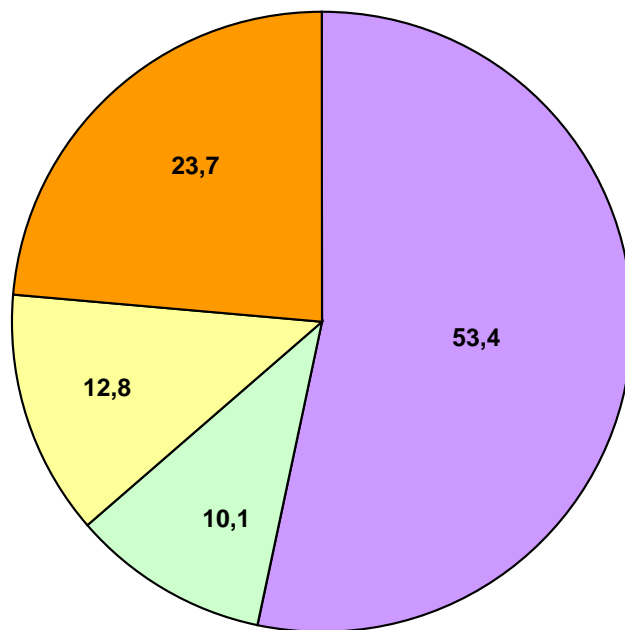


This is due to population aging and the female survival rate

- Women without difficulty or permanent limitation



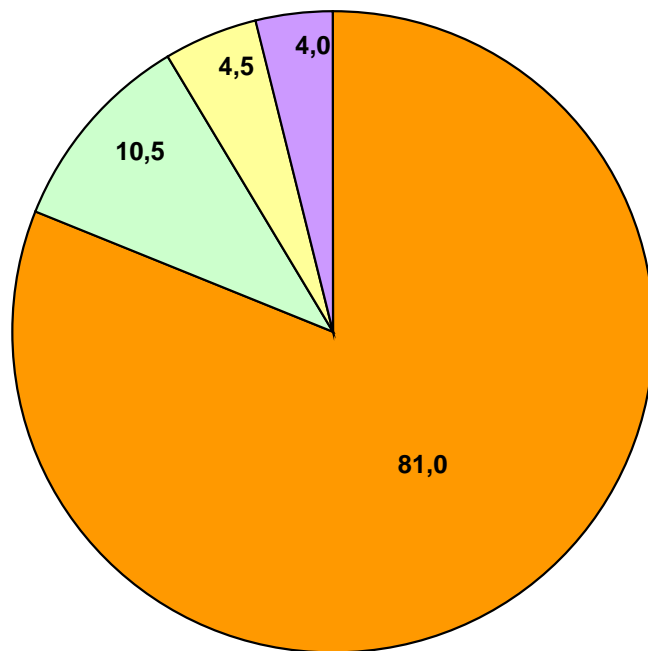
# Country total. Population with difficulty or permanent limitation that receive retirement and/or pension benefits according to type of benefit from the National Pension System. Year 2010

- Pension granted by the National Congress or Provincial Congresses

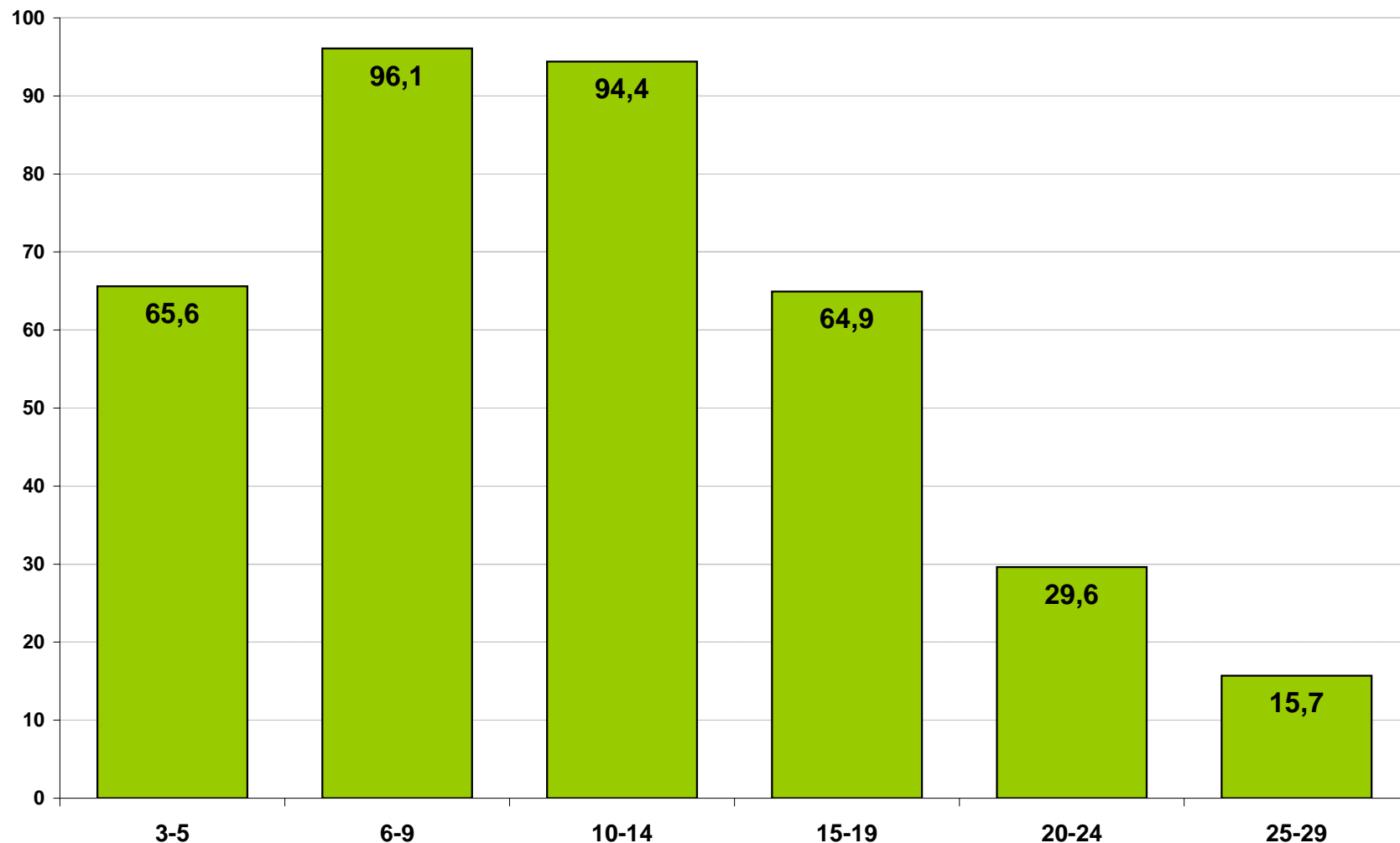
## Country total. Population with difficulty or permanent limitation with health coverage, according to type of health coverage. Year 2010



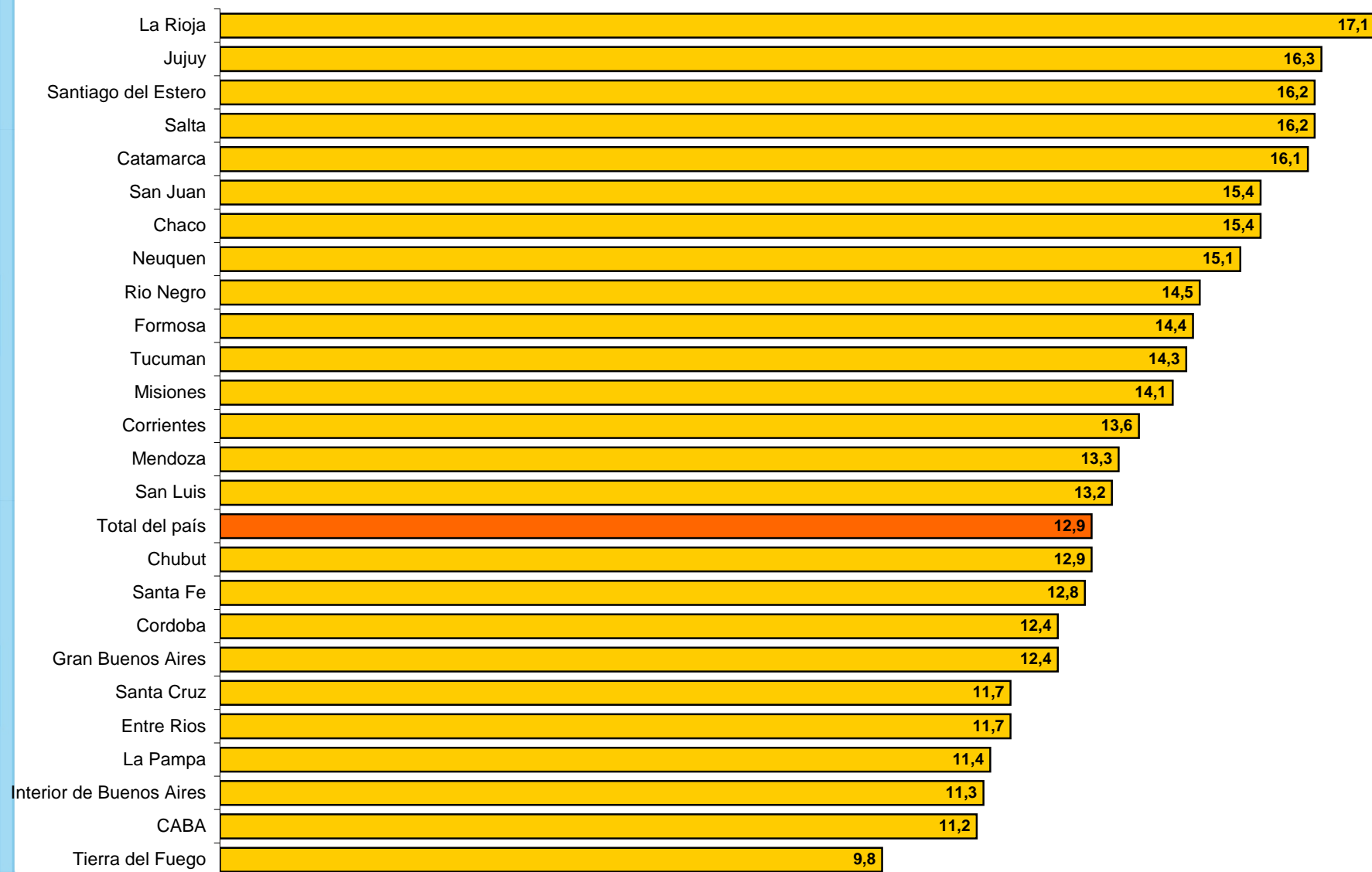

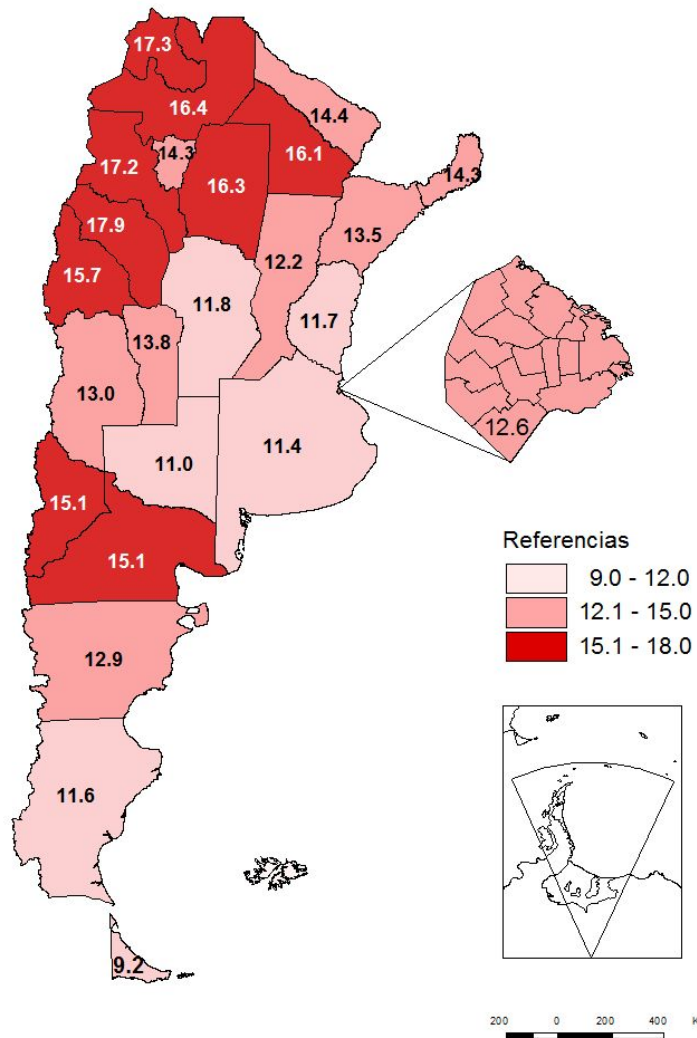
**Country total. Population of 3yrs and older with difficulty or permanent limitation that attends an educational institution, according to group age. Year 2010**



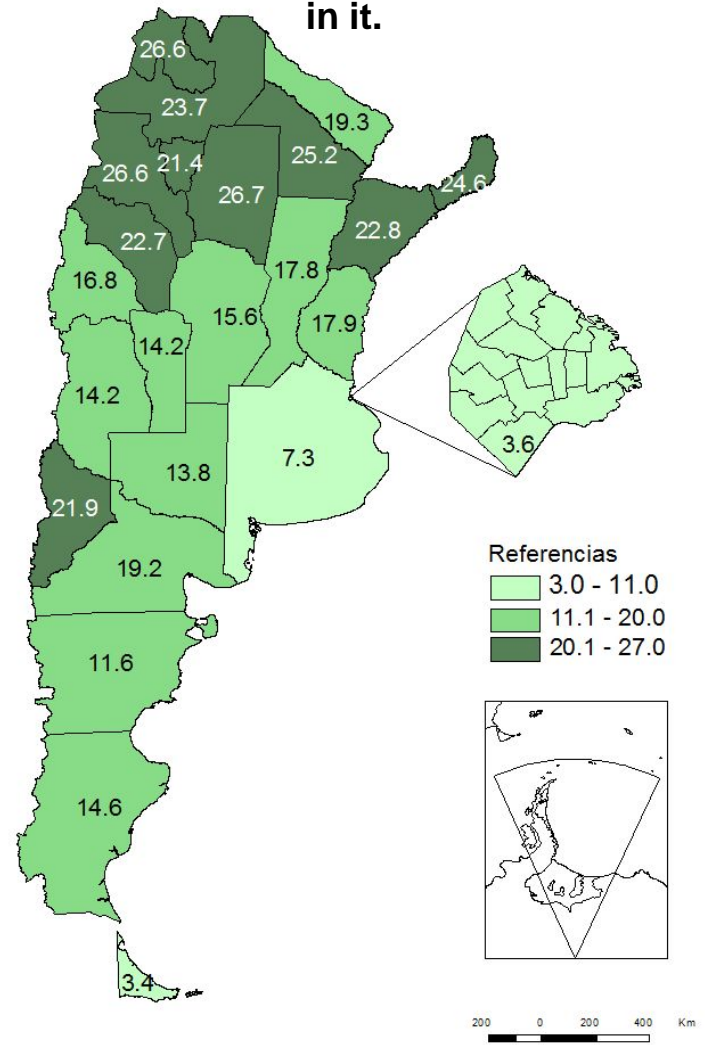
# Country total. Prevalence of difficulty or permanent limitation by province. Year 2010



## Prevalence of difficulty or permanent limitation by province.



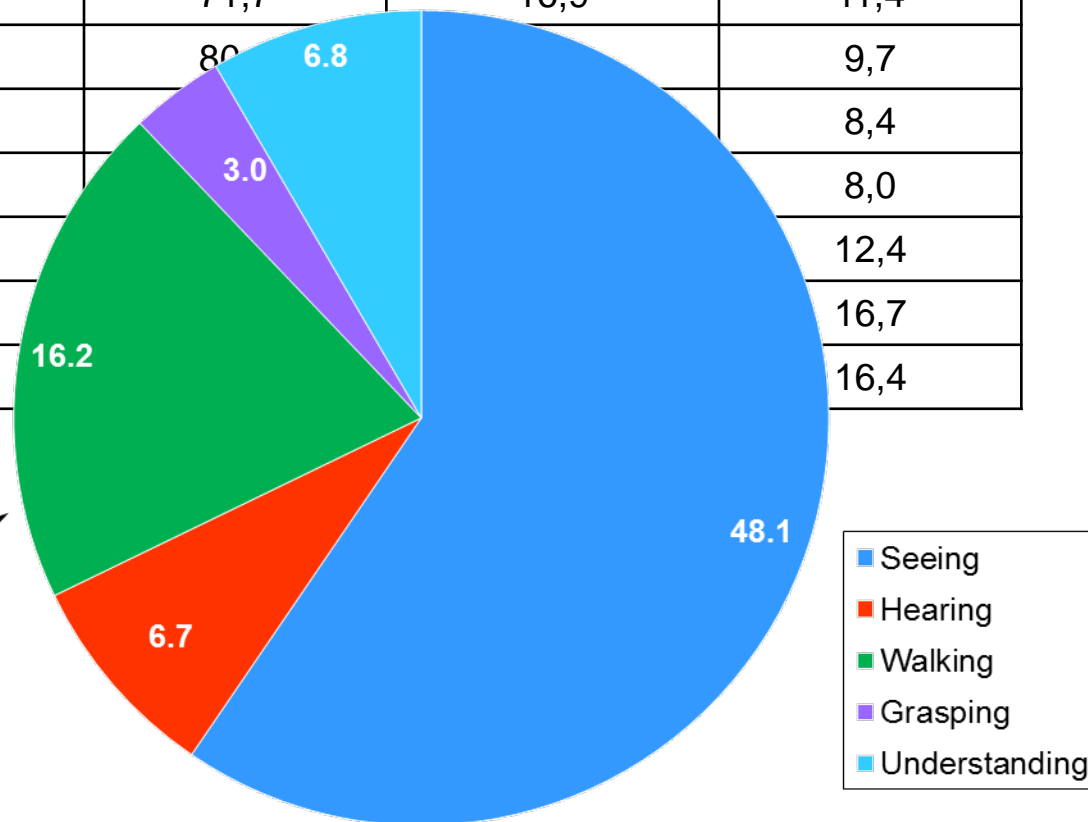
## Percentage of households with a person with disability or permanent limitation by province in it.

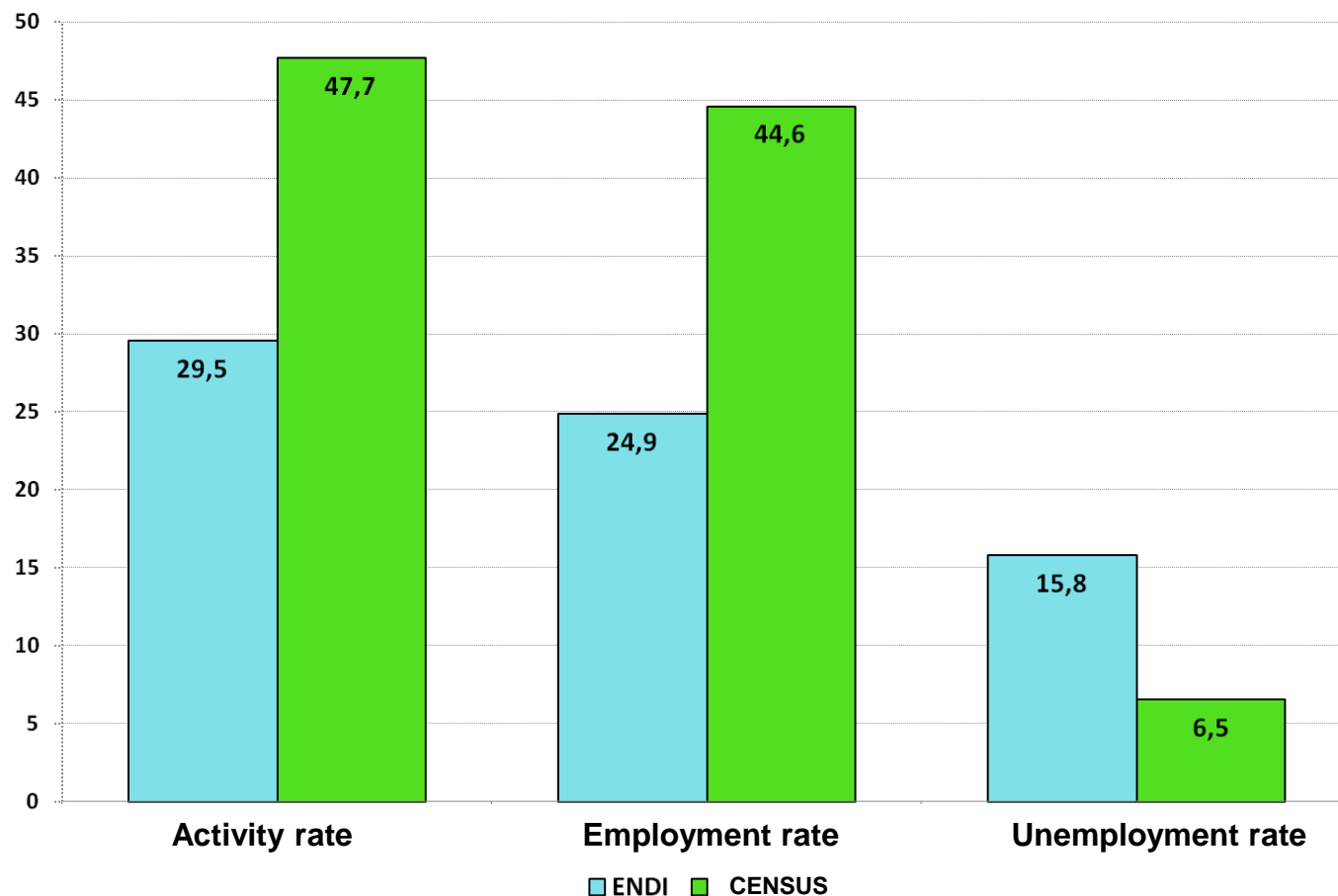
