



- 4) Does (NAME) have difficulty remembering or concentrating?
- 5) Does (NAME) have difficulty with (self-care such as) washing all over or dressing?
- 6) Because of a physical, mental or emotional health conditional, , does (NAME) you have difficulty communicating (for example understanding or being understood by others)?

#### **Response categories:**

No difficulty; Some difficulty; A lot of difficulty; Cannot do at all
