
Disability Issues - RWANDA



- > Lack of disability data, although UNCRPD was ratified in 2008
- Children with disabilities under 5 years not captured in data collection
- Identification based on medical model, only once in 2014
- > Lack of knowledge about barriers and needs of persons with disability
- > Lack of support to persons with disabilities who are most in need
- Absence of use of International validated instruments such as WGQ
- Absence of link between identification and Social Support





Age 5 – 17 years



- A case-manager will not provide disability services.
- A case-manager will support but will not take over the responsibilities.
- A case-manager will assists in the assessment, planning, referral, and monitoring of services.


